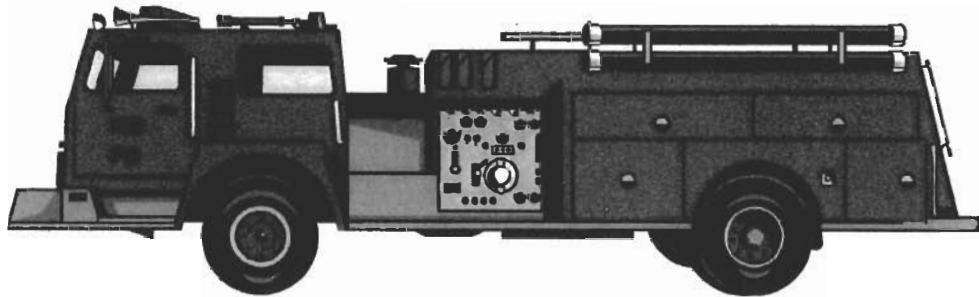

The Woman's Club of Redondo Beach is hosting a Community Spaghetti Dinner being prepared and served by the Fire Department of Redondo Beach on Saturday, April 26, 2008 from 4 to 8 p.m. at our Historical Clubhouse at 400 So. Broadway. This event is being held to raise money to buy Thermal Imaging equipment for each of our Fire Stations in both South and North Redondo Beach. Your sponsorship will help to offset the cost of the four thermal imaging cameras at \$10,000 each, which cannot be covered by the \$10 per person cost for the Spaghetti Dinner. We will be offering logo presence of sponsors on banners, tickets and all pre-event advertisements and newspaper articles as well as at the event and post-event exposure.

At the event, besides the wonderful dinner being served, there will be a live auction for 2 dinners of 4 people at each of the Firehouses, a sunset cruise on the Fire Boat in the Harbor and a ride on the fire truck through Redondo Beach after dinner. There will also be a Silent Auction and a Door Prize Drawing. Many city officials will be present at the event to offer their support.

Thermal imagers put the power of sight into the hands of firefighters, enabling them to see through blinding smoke so they can respond more effectively to fires in our community. With the help of this technology, firefighters can find unconscious victims in smoke-filled rooms, pinpoint the sources of fires, and detect structural dangers before they cause injuries and deaths.

What would the addition of thermal imagers mean to you as a corporate citizen of Redondo Beach? Thermal imagers could save precious minutes in the search for a family member or employee trapped in a burning structure. The technology could make the difference between losing your home or business to a fast-moving fire and helping firefighters gain control quickly to preserve valuable property.

Thermal imagers would fundamentally change the way they do their work at the Redondo Beach Fire Department, and it is our goal to purchase four units at a total cost of \$40,000. Thank you in advance for your donation and your support of our community.

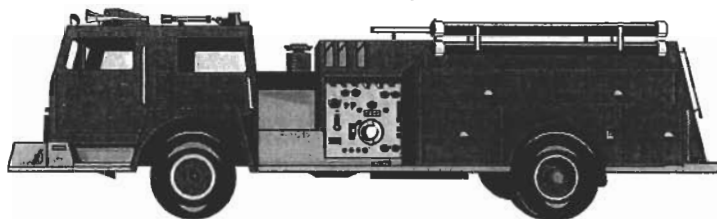
